A multi-award winner, Greg Brunton has been a prominent lighting designer for over 35 years. His scope of work includes awards shows, annual specials, pageants, concerts, variety, drama, comedy and sitcoms. His fascination with lighting has kept him on the cutting edge of technology, LED, and video. He has designed productions for all of the major networks and has designed shows emanating from five continents.

Greg has extensive experience in comedy, having long associations with sitcoms, sketch comedy, and stand-up performance. Greg designed twelve years of the series "Comedy Central Presents...", five HBO George Carlin specials, and was the original designer for "Mad TV" and "In Living Color".

His music design credits began with the legendary US Festival, and include the Rolling Stones concert film "Let's Spend the Night Together", three television specials with Diana Ross, and a thirty year association with Cher, having designed the lighting for most of her television performances since the late 1970's. His designs include a wide variety of musical performances from Faith Hill, Elton John, Dolly Parton, Green Day, Stevie Wonder, Hank Williams Jr., Reba McEntire, Rascal Flats, John Mellencamp, Ozzy Osborne, to concerts by seven world-renowned symphonies

Greg has designed lighting for a wide variety of awards shows, including the Emmy Awards, his award winning design for the Oscars, and all of the annual Independent Film Spirit Awards.
